*Please note that tournament costs are predicated on the number of students attending the tournament, the number of entries we bring in each division, transportation/lodging for overnight tournaments and the number of volunteers vs. judges that we need to hire. Costs are divided evenly amongst each division.

*In order to qualify to the Varsity State Tournament (which is our goal for as many students as possible to attend this capstone experience) students must attend at least two in-state tournaments and reach a particular level of elimination round (set by the number of tournament attendees) in order to earn a qualifying bid to state. Students must earn at least two qualifying bids.

*In order to qualify for the Tournament of Champions, students must reach a set elimination level at a minimum of two high-level national competitions over the course of the season. Bids are listed where we know the elimination level. Speech bids are set by the number of entries in a division so they will be announced closer to a tournament.
